



In Person Worship

We've had in person worship for several Sundays at 11 am. An average of 35 persons have attended each week with about half of those being the staff and volunteers who provide leadership and assistance. We've found that we can do many things live and have increased that to include the Welcome, Invocation, Confession and Absolution, spoken Kyrie, Collect, Care Ministry, Offering words, and Holy Communion. In coming weeks we will expand those to include the Apostles Creed, Prayers of the Church and Lord's Prayer. Singing and congregational responses are muted (with masks on) and we have learned that there are other ways to participate than with full voice. We can slap a thigh, express ourselves with our hands and movements, use sign language with one another. We continue to caution folks not to attend the service if any of the COVID-19 warnings apply to their household. All are invited to respect the choices that others make in these days.
