What do we have to do?

We encourage your family to complete a service project together sometime during the school year. As many of your family members as possible should participate. The type of project is up to you, but your family is encouraged to look for an opportunity to serve in an area that is interesting and meaningful to you.

What are the time requirements?

Some options in the community could include: neighborhood clean-up day, volunteering at a school or community event, volunteering at ECHO, adopt an elderly neighbor (help with yard work, groceries, etc.), or doing a food drive.
